Board of Assessment Appeals

Minutes from Meeting September 15th, 2010 6 p.m. Lisbon Town Hall

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Ruth McDonald Chairman Members present: Ruth McDonald, Kim Lang, John Magness

II. Hearing of Appeal

Michael Lutzen of 112 North Burnham Highway, Lisbon appeals \$3,400 tax levied on 2000 Chevrolet S-10 pickup truck

Mr. Lutzen was sworn in by Ruth McDonald

Mr. Lutzen contends that the value of the vehicle is significantly less than \$3,400. He purchased the vehicle for \$400. NADA Clean Retail Price value is listed as \$5,450 with a deduction of \$150 because the vehicle is 4 cylinders. The tax is assessed on the clean value of \$5,300.

After reviewing the paperwork, an inspection of the vehicle was made. The mileage is 139,143. Mr. Lutzen is not in disagreement with the method of arriving at the assessed value, but feels the vehicle is not worth \$5,300.

The board questioned why the 2008 grand list was lower than the 2009 grand list.

Mr. Lutzen left the meeting.

Kim Lang checked with Susan Rainville on the methods and guidelines used and the disparity between the 2008 and 2009 lists. She was advised that used cars were worth more in 2009 because of the faltering economy. Further, Ms. Lang was advised that mileage may be considered. The mileage should be considered as of October the previous year.

The board reviewed the NADA guidelines for the appellant's model and year, adjusting for the estimated the mileage that was on the vehicle for October 2009. The base value of \$4,950 was arrived at. The assessed value would then be \$3,465. The board decided this was a fair tax. Ruth McDonald completed the adjustment form.
