2. FY 2024/2025 General Government Proposed Budget Presentation

Thomas Sparkman, First Selectman, presented the proposed General Government Budget of \$3,780,278.00, increase by \$587,886 (18.24%) over the last (2023/2024) Fiscal Year. Key components of the budget included a significant increase in recycling contract, employee insurance and LER funding previously covered with ARPA funds.

3. FY 2024/2025 Board of Education Proposed Budget Presentation

lan Rogers, BOE Chairman, presented and Sally Keating assisted in clarifying the proposed Education Budget of \$10,892,770 increased by 1.93% over the last (2023/2024) Fiscal Year. Key components of the budget included additional funding for a .60 FTE Assistant Principal, additional funding for a social worker which had previously been covered with ARPA funds, increase in Medical Insurance, contractual wage increases, new reading series for grades 4 & 5, plus transportation and tuition increases. The Chairman requested a five (5) year Capital Improvement Plan for further reference.
