

Dear Selectmen,

It is the recommendation of the Conservation Commission that the town take action to accept as open space certain portions of the Lisbon Industrial Park at 425 S. Burnham Highway as part of the development of a proposed C&D Recycling Facility. The applicant has identified a number of wetlands and watercourses, primarily on the eastern and southern portions of the property in the process of developing his plan that are worthy of preservation. A town owned property (Map 1, Block 85?) of 27.8 acres is adjacent to the Shetucket River and north of the town owned boat launch. In addition, another town-owned property is located along the Shetucket River south of the Lisbon-Taftville bridge. Western portions of the parcel proposed for development are in the Conceptual Open Space Corridor and a Potential Open Space Linkage envisioned in the Town of Lisbon's 2004 Plan of Conservation and Development.

The parcel proposed for development is adjacent to the highly populated Laurier Lane and Ethel Acres Road areas as well as immediately north of the even more densely populated Blissville Pond area. The parcel also is adjacent to Preston-Allen Road where it meets the southern edge of Interstate 395.

We therefore recommend the town obtain as open space a 100 to 200 foot wide corridor along the entire eastern edge of the property from Preston-Allen Road to South Burnham Highway, with linkage to Laurier Lane. An additional corridor 50 to 100 foot in width should also be obtained south of the proposed development activity to provide a linkage to the town owned parcel along the Shetucket River.

We respectfully request that you take our recommendation into consideration for the benefit of current and future town residents.
