

Dear Mr. Gwiazdowski:

Based on your request to fill in the existing sediment basin on your property located at 180 Newent Road, the Town of Lisbon Conservation Commission at its November 20th 2017 regularly scheduled meeting voted in favor to permit the filling with the following conditions:

- 1. The basin is to be filled to match the existing topography so as to prevent channeled or focused storm water runoff and erosion. A shallow depressed area (+/-3 feet in depth, with 4:1 slopes) or a berm of similar height and grade should be left in the area of the basin to attenuate storm water runoff during significant storm events, especially in the spring when infiltration is minimal.
- 2. Upon final grading, the area shall be top dressed with a minimum of 4 inches of topsoil, be seeded with landscape mix and covered with mulch hay.
- 3. The Wetlands Agent shall be contacted upon commencement and completion of the project.
- 4. In the event that any land disturbing activity occurs in the area, the basin will need to be re-excavated to prevent sedimentation and erosion from moving down slope into the wetlands.
