

The Shooting Stars is the support organization for the Lisbon Senior Center. Over the years it has purchased various tables and chairs, two pool tables (which it also maintains), refrigerator and dishwasher, several television sets, sports equipment, craft supplies, etc. It also paid for minor building modifications like the built-in bookcases in the library. This is the sponsoring group for the day and overnight trips and luncheon outings. It subsidizes special meal events like the annual holiday gathering in December and activities with neighboring senior centers. Five monetary awards are presented every year to members of the graduating class of Lisbon Central School.

In order to accomplish all this, several yearly fund raisers are planned and held. For many years there was a semiannual and then annual yard sale. This has given way to a semiannual craft fair. The first one was held at the beginning of May and the next one is planned for the beginning of November and will include the highly successful pen turning event and quilt show. The students at Lisbon Central School look forward to the Christmas craft sale where they can purchase handmade items for gift giving.

As with many organizations in this day and age, the active membership is going down. The craft making sessions and monthly meetings are being attended by fewer and fewer people. If you feel the work of the Shooting Stars is worthwhile won't you consider attending one of our meetings? They are held after lunch (approximately 12:30) on the second Wednesday of each month. A new meeting format is being tried out — a round-table discussion type rather than an organized formal head table. We are also in desperate need of a recording secretary to take notes at both the Executive Board and general membership meetings.

It is always best to make your suggestions, ideas and criticisms known at a meeting so they can be properly considered. Please come and ioin us. We're a friendly bunch!


